Entries will be taken at Centre ring on Show Day (unless otherwise specified).  
There may be some changes to this class prior to show day.

**All riders must sign an indemnity form before they enter, including horse identification details.**

**The Temora Show Society maintains the right to randomly drug test horse entries under the Disciplinary Rules of the ASC.**

**All entrants MUST wear AS/NZS38-38 Standard helmets to compete.  
“NO HELMET - NO RIDING”**

## **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:**

**ENTRIES:** Each competitor must enter in his or her own name.

**ENTRY FEES:** \$3 per entry (unless otherwise stated).

**PRIZE MONEY:** As listed, to be paid at ringside immediately after Grand Parade.

**JUDGING:** Judging will commence punctual as per the timetable, and all exhibitors must be in, otherwise the events will proceed without them.

**LOOSE BOXES:** A limited number of loose boxes for stallions are available for rental at \$10 per day or yards may be rented for \$2 per day. Pay at Caravan in main ring early Saturday.

**LOCAL:** The word “Local”, in all horse sections, shall mean within a radius of 50 kilometers from the Temora Post Office.

**NOVICE:** The word Novice shall mean a horse which has not won first prize at any Agricultural Show.

**DISPUTES:** Any person wishing to lodge a protest must do so in writing accompanied with \$20, which may be forfeited if the protest is found frivolous.

Once a horse has won a 1<sup>st</sup> place, Champion or Reserve in the Pony, Galloway or Hack Open Classes, and the Pony, Galloway or Hack Show Hunters Class in the 1<sup>st</sup> ring, they are ineligible to compete in the 2<sup>nd</sup> ring. Adults and child classes are exempt.

**GRAND PARADE: All prize winners MUST take part in the Grand Parade at 3.15pm Saturday otherwise prize money and trophies may be forfeited.** All to assemble at the trotting marshalling area at approximately 3.15pm for the parade to start at 3.30pm. **Grand parade prize** - all participants in the grand parade will receive a ticket and the lucky entrant will win \$100 cash donated by *Fritsch Bros. Temora*.

**The Ringmaster’s decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.**
