All exhibitors must complete an entry and indemnity form.

Exhibits cannot be removed before 7pm Saturday.

Exhibit tickets must be presented before collecting exhibits or trophies.

All exhibits to be the work of the exhibitor during the three years preceding the show except where stated otherwise.

Any articles competing in any other section cannot compete in collections.

All exhibits to be unwashed, unless otherwise specified. All knitting to have wool label or wool sample attached.

Exhibits sent by mail will incur a \$10 postage handling fee to be paid prior to the parcel being accepted. Items be securely packed in strong boxes; a label must be firmly attached with the name of exhibitor and exhibit number thereon to expedite return in same boxes. Return postage must be included.

No prize will be awarded in any Section unless more than one Entry, except where the judge recommends Exhibit as being exceptional merit. Where Exhibits exceed 5 in any one Section a Second Prize will be paid, otherwise Second Prizes will be at the discretion of the judge.

15. Best Piece of Cross Stitch
16. Hand embroidered table centre.
17. Machine embroidered article.
18. Heirloom work.
19. Best cushion cover, any work.
20. Best apron.
21. Coat hanger, other than plastic.
22. Best patchwork featured bag
23. Best patchwork featured cot cover.
24. Best quilting, (state if commercially or domestically quilted).
25. Article featuring stitchery.
26. Article featuring smocking
27. Best child's fancy dress.
28. General Needlework for Display Only. May have a name displayed.
