All exhibitors must complete an entry and indemnity form.

All exhibits must be the bona fide work of the exhibitor, which have not been exhibited at previous shows of this society and work of the previous twelve months.

The term “Original” implies that paintings are not copied.

No exhibit may be entered in more than one competition.

All exhibits in this Class to be mounted and to have cords ready for hanging, uncoated wire is not acceptable Drawings may be exhibited under glass.

Any work not ready for hanging will be disqualified.

Exhibitors are asked to note that correct presentation (framing, mounting etc.), will receive consideration in judging.

Children’s work is to be mounted on cardboard.

Exhibits sent by mail will incur a \$10 postage handling fee to be paid prior to the parcel being accepted.

Items be securely packed in strong boxes; a label must be firmly attached with the name of exhibitor and exhibit number thereon to expedite return in same boxes. Return postage must be included.

Exhibit tickets must be firmly attached to the front of the respective exhibits and in the case of collections; the exhibits must all bear the section number and exhibitor’s entry number neatly attached.

Exhibits cannot be removed before 7pm Saturday.

Exhibit tickets must be presented before collection of exhibits or trophies
